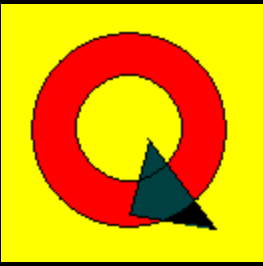
Sin broke into the creation like a lightning bolt.
