MINUTES

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Osceola met for a Public Hearing Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. at the Osceola Town Hall, Dresser, Wisconsin.

THE PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING WAS TO LISTEN TO PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING DISCONTINUING A PORTION OF 68TH AVENUE.

CHAIRMAN DOUG SCHMIDT CALLED THE PUBLIC HEARING TO ORDER AT 6:36 P.M.

Chairman Schmidt verified that the Public Hearing notice had been published in the April 5th, April 12th and the April 19th publications of the SUN newspaper and posted at the Town Hall, Dresser Post Office, First National Community Bank and the website.

A Public hearing was called to hear public comment regarding discontinuing a portion of 68th Avenue in the NE ¼ of the NW 1/4 , S32, T33N, R18W in the town of Osceola. At the March 14, 2017 Town Board meeting, the Town Board of Supervisors, in a unanimous vote, approved initiating the process to discontinue the last .10 miles of 68th Avenue and called a public hearing to hear comment.

This end portion of 68th Avenue extends onto a 40-acre parcel 042-00796-0000 owned by Keith Johnson that has been used in his farm operation.

No public comment was offered for or against and no written comments were submitted.
